1. **anxious**: afraid or nervous especially about what may happen
2. **barrier**: a law, rule, problem, etc. that makes something difficult or impossible
3. **civic**: of or relating to a city or town or the people who live there
4. **disgrace**: to cause (someone) to feel ashamed
5. **eventually**: at some later time; in the end
6. **frank**: used to say that someone is speaking or writing in a very direct and honest way
7. **glimpse**: to look at or see (something or someone) for a very short time
8. **huddle**: to come together to talk about something privately
9. **justice**: fair treatment
10. **lag**: to move more slowly than others (usually behind)
